

ST. WENCESLAUS FOOTBALL POLICY

The mission of the St. Wenceslaus Athletic Committee is to provide a positive experience while teaching the basics of the game of football in a Christian atmosphere.

This Policy will be made available to all players and parents/guardians before committing to play on a St. Wenceslaus team. Completion of the registration process signifies that at least one of the player's parents/guardians and the player has read the policy and agrees to abide by the policies of the Athletic Department and Football Program.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT

All football coaches (both head and assistant) need to be certified by the Archdiocese of Omaha as having completed the Safe Environment Training and having a background check completed prior to coaching at St. Wenceslaus. The St. Wenceslaus Football Committee will be responsible for making sure that all coaches are certified.

Any clinic or camp attended by a team in an environment where a coach, staff member, or volunteer is not Safe Environment trained will need to have a Safe Environment trained coach or staff member in attendance at the entire clinic or camp in which the team is attending.

TEAM SELECTION

In order to play St. Wenceslaus Football a player must:

- Meet the eligibility requirements set out by the PAL League
- Attend 5-day School or the St. Wenceslaus Catechetical program
- Be a member of St. Wenceslaus Parish or attend another Catholic school that does not have a PAL League Team.
- Meet all eligibility requirements set out by St. Wenceslaus School. If a student is deemed ineligible to participate in extra-curricular activities due to grades or conduct, the student will not be allowed to attend or participate in practices or any other aspect of the activity until all requirements are met and the student is again deemed eligible.
- Complete an online football registration form.
- Remit payment of the fee to the Football Coordinator
- Registration will be open to 7th and 8th grade boys. There will be no limit to roster size.
- Registration will take place in the spring preceding the season.

PRACTICES

- Practices will be limited to three times per the school week at no more than two hours per practice.
- There will be no practices after 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and prior to 2:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- Missing practice will affect playing time.

PLAYING TIME

- All players should make a commitment to his/her team and teammates.
- By missing required practices, he/she could see playing time reduced in league games.

GAMES

- No home games will be held at St. Wenceslaus facilities after 4:00 p.m. on Saturday and before 2:00 p.m. on Sunday.

GRIEVANCES

- Grievances will first be addressed by the Chairperson of the sport involved. This Chairperson will then take the grievance to the Committee of that sport for resolution. If the issue cannot be resolved by that Committee, the Chairperson will take the issue to the President of the Athletic Committee. The President, at his/her discretion, will either contact all members by email or call a special meeting of the Athletic Committee to resolve the issue. The Athletic Committee will gather information, follow-up with the aggrieved party to allow for due process, make a decision and follow through with this decision. Anonymous complaints will not be considered.
- In the event that a grievance involves a coach who is also the Chairperson of that sport, the issue may be addressed directly with the President of the Athletic Committee.
