

Comments on Large Scoring Differentials from the CYC Sports Director:

Any time a basketball team gets to 20-25 point lead, depending on the age, then things need to change:

- No press.
- No fast break points. Get the ball over the division line, and then wait for your team, and set up an offense.
- Pass the ball on offense at least five times before shooting.
- NO three point shots.
- Try playing teams at another position.
- On defense, a zone or soft man-to-man. No trapping.
- If a team has not scored; let them score. You do this by telling your players to play defense with arms straight up. Don't try to block shot. Let them shoot.

There is no excuse for shutting out a team. None. It is unsportsmanlike and does not respect the other team or the game. There is no place for this in the CYC.
