



THINGS TO BRING TO SAILING CLASS

Below please find a list of items needed for the week. Please make sure all items are in a beach bag. Names should be on all personal items.

- All students should come each day with their bathing suits on and a cover- up or sweatshirt.
- Closed toed water shoes. No flip flops.
- Hat, sunglasses, towel, change of clothes
- Jacket or foul weather gear if weather conditions warrant
- Sunscreen should be applied at home.
- Bottle of water. A plastic bottle frozen the night before works well.
- Life jacket – NYSS has life jackets available for all sailors but you are welcome to bring your own if it's a Coast Guard approved type 111 PFD.
- **Two face masks:** one to wear & a spare. Masks will be worn on shore but not in the water.

ATTENDANCE

Students should be dropped off at the NYSS Boat House on South Beach (105 Bay Street) at 8:45 for morning sessions and 12:45 for afternoon sessions. No early drop offs are permitted. Children dropped off prior to 8:45 and 12:45 are not under supervision and are not the responsibility of NYSS. Additionally, class ends promptly at noon for the morning session and 4 pm for the afternoon session. If you cannot be at the Boat House to pick up your child, please make other arrangements.

Arriving to class on time is important. If a sailor arrives late, he or she will miss important information related to safety and day's activities.

Bad weather – normally, we hold class in the boat house if the weather is bad. Due to Covid-19, we can't put enough distance between people to be safe. Therefore, we may have to cancel class. Please be available to pick up your child if the weather gets bad.
