

High School Division: June Session

Guidelines:

1. **Equipment** - no sharing of helmets, gloves, batting gloves.
 - a. **Bat** - when a bat is shared between players, equipment will be wiped down with a clorox wipe before another player will be able to use.
 - b. All player equipment will be kept with the player and not stored in the dugout.
2. **Dugout** - only one coach will be allowed to stay in the dugout along with 3 other players during offensive turns. Remaining players will be separated on the bleachers. Batting bags will be hung inside the dugout and along the fence adjacent to the bleachers.
3. **Managers, Coaches & Umpires** will be required to wear a face mask.
 - a. Umpires will be adult volunteers
4. **Catcher** - will be required to stand at the backstop of the diamond. Players will not be allowed to take a normal position behind the home plate and batter. This will allow social distancing between batter and umpire.
 - a. Catchers are not required to wear catcher's equipment. Catchers may wear their own personal equipment, but cannot share catcher's equipment.
 - b. ASL does have umpire masks available and can be wiped down for use.
5. **Health Requirements** - Players will be asked prior to each game/practice if they have any of the following: fever (100.4), respiratory issues or have been exposed to someone who has COVID-19.
6. **Social Distancing**
 - a. There will be no physical contact for celebrations (ie: high fives, pats on the back, home run celebrations, end-game handshake, etc.)
 - b. Foul balls & Home Run balls will not be returned to game play. They will be collected after the game for sanitizing.
7. Hand sanitizer and clorox wipes will be provided at each dugout.
8. **Spectators**: Spectators will not be allowed on the bleachers or along the side of the fence line. Spectators will only be allowed in the grassy side along the outfield and be 6ft apart from each other.
 - a. Concessions and playground will be closed
 - b. Children that are not participating in the game must stay with adults
9. **Game Details** -
 - a. Game times will be limited to 60 minutes
 - b. Games will be played on M/W (maybe F) at 6:00, 7:15, 8:30
 - c. Warm Ups will be limited to 30 minutes prior to game time.
 - d. Teams will arrive promptly to diamond, 5 minutes prior to game time.
 - e. Teams and spectators from prior game will immediately leave diamond to allow teams to enter.
 - f. Team discussions after games will need to take place at away from diamond.

- h. Practices will begin on Monday, June 15
- i. Games will begin Wednesday June 17 thru Monday, June 29 (possible Friday games included).
- j. Pool Tourney
 - i. June 30-July 1 Round Robin (2-day tourney)
 - ii. July 2 - Championship & awards to follow

10. Team Selection

- a. Based on player availability teams will be filled based on player responses
- b. 8th grade players not electing to participate in HS division in January, will be given the opportunity to participate.
- c. All teams formed for the 2020 June Season will be considered temporary and not follow normal HS Division bi-laws.
