

Some Game Reminders

Cards, Approved Rosters, and a Completed Game Card are required at every game. Electronic copies of cards and approved rosters can be used for league but not playoff games. The umpires should check these before the meeting with coaches.

Please have game cards completed before the start of the game. This is the record of participants and they are saved. The game card is created from the spread sheet available from your Lay Director. The umpire keeps game cards.

If a game is forfeited at the field, a practice game can be played if desired. The umpires should officiate the game.

Game lengths are as follows for grades 3-4. No new inning starts after the time limit.

Baseball	90 min
Softball	80 min

The run limit per inning is 5.

The Mercy Rule is 15 after 3 innings, 12 after 4 innings, and 10 after 5 innings.

The coach who comes to the plate for the meeting on ground rules serves as the point of contact for the umpires. He/she is identified as the head coach.
